Status of 2011 MOA Budget Request:

The Assembly and the Mayor have approved \$80,000 in funds for the 2011 grant to the FCC. We appreciate all of the council officers who spoke to Assembly members in support of our budget request.

Use of 2011 MOA Contract funds:

With a greatly reduced MOA contract, we will have to be very efficient with the funds we do have. To that end, we ask you to greatly reduce the size of your USPS mailing lists. We do not wish to eliminate USPS mailings at this time, just reduce them greatly. So please contact your USPS newsletter recipients and ask them to convert over to email. The FCC has lessened the cost of our mailing contract by reducing the minimums we pay each month, but now we must further shrink the USPS mailing lists. Thanks in advance for your help.
