<u>President's Report</u>: The latest news release from AHFC regarding the award of the \$26 million contract for the new Loussac Manor to Cook Inlet Housing Authority was distributed. Those in attendance requested a presentation of the new development plans as soon as possible. The plan was to invite AHFC and /or Cook Inlet Housing Authority to the January meeting.

Treasurer's Report:

1. Funds in the SACC account are \$2,907.49.

Other Reports:

- 1. <u>Representative Les Gara</u> stopped by and introduced himself wishing all a happy holiday season.
- 2. <u>Senator Johnny Ellis' Representative</u>, <u>Ann Marie</u>, (phone: 269-0169) was present to collect community concerns and to invite phone calls on constituent concerns.
- 3. Assembly Member Patrick Flynn discussed:
 - Proposed Muni Budget cuts may cost jobs if bus routes like Route 45g are discontinued. That route is a critical link for Fairview and Mt. View to get downtown to work.
 - Aircraft taxes will double under Muni "user fee" proposals to raise added revenue (from \$75 for a single engine plane to \$150 annually). Event fees at the Parks may also be increased.

New Business:

- 1. No new Motions or resolutions were presented.
- 2. Matt Johnson from North Star Community Council asked that a committee be formed consisting of members of North Star and South Addition Community Councils and others to brainstorm the further cleaning up and development of Valley of The Moon Park with a first meeting to be organized by the end of February of 2011 with a visual inspection of the Park as soon as break-up allows.
