Also state employees will now be able to have routine preventative colonoscopy screening coverage before age 65.
- 2. <u>Senator Johnny Ellis' Representative , Amory Neilig</u>, (phone: 269-0169) was present to collect community concerns and to invite phone calls on constituent concerns. Sen. Ellis is working to find more funds for substance abuse programs. He is also working on an engineering building for UAA and an extension of the Film Incentive Bill and a new bill to require heath ins. Providers to cover proven autism therapies.
- 3. Assembly Member Patrick Flynn discussed:
  - Homeless Camps in local parks are being dismantled so please make your United Way contributions so that Community Services can continue its outreach to the homeless. Homeless in need of help can call 211—a dedicated help response line.
