**Resolution: Extension of the comment period to give all RPCC Members ample time for comment, and, requesting a public hearing held at the end of the comment period for Cell Tower at 2100 E. Northern Lights**

WHEREAS, Rogers Park Community Council is an established set of neighborhoods consisting nearly entirely of R-1 and R-2 lots with a short strip of B-1A (local and neighborhood) lots; and

WHEREAS, many residents of RPCC were unaware of proposed 100' tower; and

WHEREAS, placement of a cell tower at 2100 E. Northern Lights Boulevard will severely affect the property values of Rogers Park Community Council parcels; and

WHEREAS, Municipality of Anchorage tax assessments will be negatively affected.

**NOW, therefore, be it resolved that the Rogers Park Community Council requests an extension of the comment period to give all RPCC Members ample time for comment, and, a public hearing be held at the end of the comment period.**

PASSED AND APPROVED by Rogers Park Community Council this 14th day of May, 2012.
