Draft Alternative 5

2nd North-South Runway

IMPACTS: Massive amount of fill placed into Cook Inlet/Anchorage Wildlife Coastal Refuge, destroy Pt. Woronzof Park and a section of the EXISTING Coastal Trail west of Airport. Trail would have to be relocated around runway or tunneled underneath it.
