

## **Campbell Park Community Council**

Meeting Minutes for August 15, 2013

### **CALL TO ORDER**

The Campbell Park Community Council (CPCC) meeting was called to order at 7:40p.m. on Thursday, August 15, 2013 by Council Chair Kevin Fimon at St. Mary's Church.

### **PRESENT**

A total of 17 community members were present including four firefighters from Station four, Assemblyman Dick Traini, Legislative Aide Meghan Cavanaugh from State Representative Andy Josephson's office and Aide Noah Hanson from State Senator Berta Gardner's office.

### **REPORTS**

Firefighter Forth reported that there are 11 new recruits in the training program. A burning ban restriction is currently in place and a reminder that the fire station is open for tours during normal business hours, as long as they were not on a call. In answer to a question, the firefighters feel they have been provided most of the modern equipment now in use and very good training.

### **ASSEMBLY REPORT – DICK TRAINI**

Assemblyman Traini reported that the Assembly approved and initiated the "bar safety hour" for a 3:00a.m. sweep (no liquor sales) after closing to allow patrons to get cabs or rides home. He has proposed a new "non-concessional" towing and taxicab ordinances. The Assembly is also working to update the status of Port Director under the "mayor takeover."

### **LEGISLATIVE REPORT**

Meghan Cavanaugh reported that Representative Josephson is attending a University of Alaska subcommittee budget survey in Fairbanks. Mr. Josephson is also touring Fort Knox and Usibelli mines.

Noah Hanson reported that Senator Gardner attended an "Education Summit" for financing issues. He also reported that Ms. Gardner is working with Rick Solberg, co-owner of The Natural Pantry, on the new stand-alone building on the corner of 36th Avenue and A Street.
