- iii. The intent is to start the replacements/updates this Fall. The bid is going out next week.

iv. Next step is for the Assembly to act and accept the grants and project agreement on September 24<sup>th</sup>.

i. Stephenson Park and Oceanview Park – 2014 Volunteer Park Fix-it-Day – we will need 8 local community members for our VIP Board, which will start meeting in late September.

# c. Johns Road Updates:

- i. Contractors were great they provided extra flaggers
- **ii.** Sean Holland, the PM, stated that they came across an old sewer line that was still active. The QAP Contractor said there has been a lot of daily surprises and unforeseen issues.
