Regular Meeting Minutes

December 18, 2013

Meeting called to order at 7:05pm.

We were short one person for a quorum

1. Treasurers Report balance of \$1,967.16
2. FCC Report – they are currently updating the website
3. Bayshore/Klatt contacted us about their community patrol; they have more information if we would like it.
4. Senator Maguire – getting ready for the new session to begin
5. Representative Johnson represented by Josh Walton. They did receive our capitol request for 120th, Johns Klatt intersection and Oceanview and Stephenson Parks.
6. Chugach Electric had a luncheon attended by Steve Beardsley. They talked about the project in Oceanview to upgrade lights to LED and future projects in Alaska.
7. Park presentation by Stephen Rafuse and Maeve Nevins for upgrades to:
 - a. Oceanview Park. They have \$185,000 to spend on this park. New swings, a zip line and general renewal of our current park as well as rebuilding the barbeque pit and adding a container for hot coals.
 - b. Stephenson Park - \$185,000 to spend on a tree house theme. Currently the park is a blank slate. There will be an upper level with a plaza/picnic area, a 3 foot pathway all the way around for children to ride bikes and trikes.
 - c. Steve Beardsley will contact Anchorage Sand & Gravel as well as the Laborer's Training Center for support on these two projects.
 - d. South Anchorage Sports Park – there has been \$2,000,000 allotted for a rewrite of this park with a new design. A Advisory Committee will be formed to get a consensus of what the community would like to see developed into this park. Dwayne Adams will be working with this group and he wrote the original plan. The meetings should begin in late January.
8. Pete Johnson gave a report on:
 - a. LED streetlight upgrades. They redid 114 lights and they are all complete.
 - b. Furrow Creek – HDR has 95% of the design done and will bid in late winter for the work this spring. The Municipality has funded Beachcomber, Clippership and Mariner for 2014. Dan Billman is the project engineer and they may be here in January or February.
