Tod Butler, chair, called the meeting to order at 7:08 p.m. March meeting minutes were approved.

Assembly report: Dick Traini was present. Their next meeting is this Tuesday. At their meeting on the 15th they'll certify the election and new assembly members will be sworn in. 6,500 absentee votes still need to be counted, South & East Anchorage have close races that could still change. ASD budget was approved at April 2 meeting.

Federation of Community Councils (FCC) report: Capital Improvement Projects (CIP) are underway.

New business: St. Mary's Episcopal Church on Tudor/Lake Otis is planning to build 15 new units to house Senior Citizens. They're just beginning the process by putting it out for bid.

Tod reminded us that it is possible to get large amounts of money from the legislature for needed neighborhood projects or improvements, it just takes getting organized and following a process.
