2. Renewable Energy Alaska Project (REAP): 10th annual Alaska Renewable Energy Fair. 3. Creekside Holdings, LLC., has made application for a retail structure with drive through, in the B-3 SL (general business) district with special limitations. The applicant is proposing to construct a 2,380 square foot drive through restaurant on the site. The two acre property is currently developed with a constructed 14,943 square foot retail building with Walgreens Drug Store as a tenant (corner of Debarr and Creekside Center Drive. AO 2001-24(S) (AA) requires "The location of fast food and/or drive through style restaurants along Muldoon or DeBarr Roads must be approved by the Assembly." A Municipal Assembly Public Hearing will be held at July 8, 2014 meeting at the Z.J. Loussac Library.
