Old Seward/Oceanview Community Council Regular Meeting Minutes – <u>DRAFT</u> September 24, 2014

The meeting was called to order by <u>Treasurer</u> Chester House at 7:00pm. There was a quorum of members present.

Report of Officers

President Steve Beardsley was not present.

Vice-President (Position vacant)

Secretary KC Elliot was not present.

<u>Treasurer</u> Chester House reported an October balance of \$2,092.78.

Visitors

- (1) State Representative Craig Johnson was present and reported no agenda, but he was willing to answer questions. There were no questions.
- (2) Rob Fitch from the MOA Office of Emergency Management talked about a state issued bulletin on "How to Build a 7 Day Emergency Prep Kit". He said that FEMA may bump that to 14 days at some point. He indicated that Anchorage, like much of Alaska, is unique in that 99% of everything comes in through the port. He also said that Chugach Electric operates solely on natural gas, while Municipal Electric has diesel as well. Emergency preparedness is important.
- (3) Chris and Patrick Kewick, both Anchorage firemen, were present. Chris spoke as an advocate for APD and AFD unions in favor of voting no, on Assembly Bill AL37.

Old Business

- (1) Johns/Klatt Road Intersection There was a brief discussion regarding roundabout concepts.
- (2) Furrow Creek Drainage Replacement culverts have been ordered for Clippership Court, Beachcomber Drive and Mariner Drive, but they are being manufactured out of state. Therefore, delivery is not expected until mid-October at the earliest. It appears that the installations will not take place until next Spring.
- (3) Oceanview and Stephenson Parks Recent improvements were reviewed and discussed.

New Business

(1) The Alaska Railroad Revised Resolution was discussed. There were at least a dozen votes for the motion and 0 votes against.
