# SACC South Addition Community Community Agenda

### Minutes of the Thursday, September 18, 2014 SACC meeting

Anchorage Pioneers' Home

- I. President Jeff Manfull called the meeting to order at 7:09 pm and introduced the new officers: Kathy Weeks, Treasurer, Cathleen Hahn, Secretary, Anna Bryant and Albert Whitehead, members-at-large. He reminded the Council one must be a resident of South Addition and have signed in for the meeting to be eligible to vote tonight.
  - A. Two changes were made to the agenda which did not impact the items being discussed.
  - B. Anna moved for approval and acceptance of the June 19, 2014 SACC minutes; no objections being heard, they were accepted as written.

### II. Reports:

- A. President Jeff Manfull (akjeff@gmail.com)

  Jeff reminded the Council of the NextDoor social media site being used to communicate with 230+ residents. He also gave a Federation of Community Councils report (Bonnie being absent tonight), including the reminder that we are operating under a default set of Bylaws until we can modify ours to meet the new requirements.
- B. Treasurer Kathy Weeks
  SACC has \$3,217.60 at the end of the last quarter; she reminded us dues are \$5/year/residence.
- C. Assembly: Patrick Flynn (<u>flynpp@ci.anchorage.ak.us</u> Josh Spring reported on several items for Mr. Flynn; among the other items he reminded us AO37 is on the November 7, 2014 ballot.

#### III. Council business:

- A. New business:
  - 1. Cell tower at E & 13<sup>th</sup> Avenue

Nick Miller, Implementation Director, GCI, was present to give background information about cell tower sites around Anchorage and reasons to develop the site being proposed on a pole in the alley near E Street and 13<sup>th</sup> Avenue. At the end of his presentation, Teresa Arnold, SACC resident, made the following motion: "South Addition Community

Council opposes the extension of the utility pole located in the alley near E Street and 13<sup>th</sup> Avenue for use as a cell site." Discussion was held and the question was called for a vote: 10 yea's, 18 nay's, motion failed.

### 2. Weidner Homes rezoning request

Tim Potter, Dowl HKM and Greg Cerbena, Weidner Property representative, were present to discuss the Weidner request to rezone four lots located near C Street and Fourteenth Avenue from RO and R3 to R4. After the presentation, Mr. McArthur, SACC resident, made the following motion: "South Addition Community Council opposes the Weidner zoning change." Discussion was held and the question was called for a vote: 29 yea's, 2 nay's, motion carried. Kathy volunteered to write a resolution on behalf of SACC based on the motion to be sent to the Planning & Zoning Committee.

Anna moved to extend our meeting to 9:30pm; no objection was heard.

# 3. 'A' Street construction Melanie San Angelo, SACC resident, updated the Council with respect to street and curb upgrades being made.

### 4. Parks and Recreation update

Holly Spoth-Torres was present to update the Council with regard to several park issues going on in our area: trail and signage improvements, installation of new art near Westchester Lagoon, and the Coastal Trail bridge replacement. The bridge will require a city bond, which is expected to be on the April 2015 ballot.

# IV. Open community comments (3 minutes each)

One resident recommended the Council ask Planning & Zoning to come and present us their five-year plan for our council area.

Another resident suggested we encourage the city to bury over-head utility lines.
