Tudor Area Community Council Meeting – Assembly Report December 4, 2014

- The Assembly held a special meeting on November 26th and approved all budgets.
- Assembly proposed several amendments. The Mayor accepted 95% of the proposed amendments. It was one of the most amicable budget processes during the six years of the current Administration. Total budget: \$473.7M almost \$200,000 under the cap.
- At the December 2nd meeting, the Assembly heard an ordinance submitted by Assembly Members Demboski and Evans to elect to allow permanent registration of certain motor vehicles and trailers within the Municipality for vehicles eight years or older. The cost would have been \$6M in additional property taxes or reduction in services. The Assembly approved allowing only trailers at a cost of \$210.000.
