

# Project Fact Sheet

## Rabbit Creek Road Pavement Preservation

DOT&PF Project No. 0504(009)/58511

### Project Scope

The Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities(DOT&PF) is proposing to resurface approximately 4.0 miles of Rabbit Creek Road from the east side of Old Seward Highway to Hillside Drive. The roadway has developed wheel path rutting, structural damage, and longitudinal and transverse cracking. The purpose of this project is to repair these deficiencies as well as improve safety, reduce maintenance costs, and extend the service life of the roadway.

This pavement preservation project will:

- Repave the road surface and restripe
- Remove the roadway sub-base in select dig-out locations
- Replace and/or repair any cross-culverts or storm drains at risk of structural failure
- Improve and/or replace guardrail and guardrail end treatments
- Replace damaged, non-reflective, or missing signs

### Schedule

Final project design will be completed in June 2015. Construction is anticipated to begin late in 2015 or in the summer of 2016.
