  - B. People convicted of "running" should also be issued restricted licenses (red stripes).
  - C. Community Patrol and other volunteers should monitor parks for overnight camping and post notice that the CAP team will be notified if they do not vacate their camps in ten days.
  - D. Community Patrols and other volunteers should provide photos and names of public inebriates to carryout stores and request these stores do not sell to these individuals.
