

TURNAGAIN COMMUNITY COUNCIL RESOLUTION 2016-03

RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF PLAYGROUND AND OTHER PARK IMPROVEMENTS TO KIWANIS FISH CREEK PARK AND BARBARA STREET PARK

WHEREAS, the Turnagain Community Council (TCC) is an all-volunteer, self-governing neighborhood organization recognized in the Municipality of Anchorage Charter; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of community councils is to provide a direct and continuing means of citizen participation in government and local affairs; and

WHEREAS, the Municipality Parks and Recreation Department and the Anchorage Park Foundation have collaborated with an advisory group of Turnagain and Spenard residents and the Girl Scouts of Alaska on installation of playground and other park improvements to Kiwanis Fish Creek Park (located within TCC boundaries) and Barbara Street Park (located within TCC and Spenard Community Council boundaries), with projected construction to occur in 2016; and

WHEREAS, recommendations identified both in a 2015 Barbara Street Park Challenge Grant and during the advisory group planning process include upgraded playground equipment, new all-inclusive turf surfacing, upgraded circulation patterns, and other amenities to improve the park user experience; and

WHEREAS, playground upgrades and other park improvements to both Kiwanis Fish Creek Park and Barbara Street Park will provide positive and active recreational activities for all members of the Turnagain and Spenard neighborhoods;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Turnagain Community Council supports playground upgrades and other improvements to Kiwanis Fish Creek Park and Barbara Street Park.
