# **Notice of Public Meeting**

Anchorage Water and Wastewater Utility (AWWU) is proposing repairs and replacements to AWWU water lines in the Bayshore Subdivision. Water lines in this area were primarily installed between 1961 and 1983, and there have been a high number of leaks and breaks in recent years. The project includes investigations of the system conditions to determine how to best repair and replace the system to eliminate leaks and provide for efficient and sustainable water service to the area. Field investigations took place this past summer, and based upon those studies, construction phasing recommendations have been approved. Construction is planned for summer 2012 and 2013.

## **Frequently Asked Questions**

# Why does the Bayshore Subdivision water system need repairs and replacements?

Water lines in this area were primarily installed between 1961 and 1983 and there have been a high number of leaks and breaks in the system in recent years. This project includes investigations of the system conditions to determine how to best repair and replace the system.

#### What are the benefits?

The repairs and replacements will reduce the potential for water line leaks and breaks requiring emergency repairs. These improvements will result in more efficient and sustainable water service

#### When will these repairs and replacements occur?

Investigations, including survey soil investigations and acoustic condition assessments, took place this past summer. Based upon those studies, construction phasing recommendations have been approved. Construction is planned for summer 2012 and 2013. The map on the next page shows the phasing construction plan for the project area affected by the water repairs and replacements.

#### Will the project team need access to my property?

Members of the project team, including personnel from AWWU and DOWL HKM and its subconsultants, may need access to your property in order to conduct various studies. If access outside existing easements is needed, you will be contacted for approval.

#### When will people be in our neighborhood?

Additional topographic survey is anticipated for Summer 2012. See the figure on the next page for more information on construction phasing.
