(Downtown Community Council)**

On **January 5, 2017** the Municipal Clerk's Office received from the Alaska Alcohol and Marijuana Control Office (AMCO), for consideration by the Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) Board, notice for the 2017/2018 liquor license renewals for the following establishments:

Restaurant/Eating Place

Café 817 LL#4449

Yamaya Restaurant LL#3728

Gumbo House LL#4275

Any AMCO violations and/or incidents that would lead to an AMCO violation are attached for the Assembly's evaluation.

There are no taxes owing.

Anchorage Municipal Code 21.50.160 requires that any use, whether principal or accessory, involving the retail, sale or dispensing of alcoholic beverage is permitted only by conditional use approved by the Assembly. **There is a Conditional Use Permit at each location that does not fall under AMC 21.50.500.**

Anchorage Municipal Code 21.50.500 states that a restaurant or eating place licensed by the State Alcoholic Beverages Control Board to sell beer and wine for consumption only on the licensed premises is exempt from the conditional use requirements of 21.50.160 and may be reviewed by the Planning Director under this section, an administrative review under this section shall occur before assembly approval of the restaurant or eating place license for beer and wine. **There is an Administrative Site Plan Review at each location.**

Alaska Statute 04.11.480 provides that if the Assembly wishes to protest the issuance, renewal, relocation or transfer of a liquor license, it may protest within 60 days following receipt of the application and the protest will be honored unless the AMCO finds the protest to be arbitrary, capricious and unreasonable. **The last day to protest is March 6, 2016.** February 28, 2016 is the last scheduled regular Assembly meeting before the end of the protest period.

Approval of this memorandum is the Assembly's NON-OBJECTION to the applications filed with AMCO for the ABC Board for the 2017/2018 liquor license

1 **renewals for the above establishments.** The Municipal Clerk is authorized to notify the
2 AMCO of the Assembly's action and is authorized to sign on its behalf.
