3	A RESOLUTION OF THE BIRCHWOOD COMMUNITY COUNCIL REGARDING THE PLATTING
4	ACTION FOR THE PROPOSED MINK CREEK SUBDIVISION
5	
6	WHEREAS, Community Councils are established under Anchorage Municipal Code Section 8.01 to
7	ensure citizens have maximum community involvement and self-determination;
8	
9	WHEREAS, a platting action has been proposed by S4 Group, LLC to subdivide approximately 203
10	acres, legally described as T15N R1W SEC 17 N2 N of Glenn Hwy, into thirteen (13) 1+
11	acre lots located north of the Glenn Highway and east of S. Birchwood Loop Road;
12	
13	WHEREAS, access to the proposed subdivision is provided by existing roads that currently do not meet
14	the standards required by the Chugiak Birchwood Eagle River Rural Road Service Area (CBERRRSA)
15	Board and Municipality of Anchorage;
16	
17	WHEREAS, these existing roads are insufficient to safely and effectively handle the increase in traffic
18	and service demands resulting from the proposed development;
19	
20	WHEREAS, neighbors have expressed significant concerns regarding the proposed subdivision's cul-de-
21	sacs not meeting Municipality of Anchorage (MOA) and Anchorage Fire Department standards,
22	potentially impacting emergency response and community safety;
23	
 24	WHEREAS, there is an additional major concern that failing to require the developer to upgrade the
25	access roads to MOA and CBERRRSA standards could result in taxpayer-funded improvements through
26	CBERRRSA, shifting financial responsibility from the developer to local taxpayers;
27	oblititition, similaring manetal responsionity nom are developed to rocal anpayers,
28	WHEREAS, ensuring road infrastructure meets required standards is essential for maintaining community
29	safety, managing traffic effectively, and safeguarding property values within Birchwood;
30	salety, managing dame encedivery, and saleguaraning property variates whilm Direnwood,
31	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Birchwood Community Council:
32	1. Insists that the Municipality of Anchorage requires the developer to upgrade and bring all
33	accessing roads up to the standards set forth by the Chugiak-Eagle River Rural Road Service Area
34	Board.
35	2. Ensures cul-de-sacs within the subdivision meet MOA and Anchorage Fire Department
36	requirements.
37	These upgrades must be completed before any platting action or approval is finalized for the proposed
38	Mink Creek Subdivision.
39	White Creek Subdivision.
40	FURTHER RESOLVES that this resolution be officially submitted to the Anchorage Platting Board and
40 41	any other relevant municipal authorities to ensure these conditions are addressed prior to any platting
42	approval.
