THE CREATION OF A COMMUNITY GARDEN

Whereas the Campbell Park Community Council is a private, voluntary, not for profit, self-governing association composed of residents, property owners, business owners, representatives from the Campbell Park Community Council neighborhood designated by the Anchorage Assembly and;

Whereas the purpose of the community councils is to provide a direct and continuing means of citizen participation in government and local affairs;

Whereas Community Councils were established in the Municipality in order to provide a direct and continuing means of citizen participation, to provide a robust debate of issues to their community, neighbors, and individuals who participate and have dialogue germane to the area in which they reside;

Whereas residents of the Campbell Park Community Council have presented before the Council a proposal for a Community Garden to be located on Municipal park land north of and adjacent to Campbell Creek west of and adjacent to Folker Street;

Whereas there is no Muni-sponsored Community Garden within three miles of the proposed site
and the largest participation in these gardens is from those within walking distance;

Whereas the Campbell Park Community Council proposes the creation of a Community Garden;

Therefore, be it resolved that the Campbell Park Community Council (CPCC) resolved that the Campbell Park Community Council hereby supports the creation of a Community Garden on Folker and Campbell Creek..
