

A RESOLUTION OF THE CAMPBELL PARK COMMUNITY COUNCIL 2025-02

A RESOLUTION THAT SUPPORTS the safety of pedestrians within boundaries of the State of Alaska, Municipality of Anchorage, and the Campbell Park Community Council;

WHEREAS the purpose of Community Councils is to provide a direct and continuing participation in government and local affairs;

WHEREAS the Campbell Park Community Council places a high standard on the quality of life, characterized by safe neighborhood streets;

WHEREAS the number of pedestrian deaths in Anchorage has increased to record levels in recent years, often on streets with speed limits of 45 miles per hour;

WHEREAS Tudor Road is a major thoroughfare on which more than twenty nine thousand motor vehicles travel daily, often exceeding the posted speed limit of 45 mph;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Campbell Park Community Council requests that State of Alaska, Department of Transportation reduce the speed limit from 45 miles per hour to 35 miles per hour on East Tudor Road between Lake Otis Parkway and Elmore Road, and to 40 miles per hour on other portions of Tudor Road; to install permanent speed feedback signs on Tudor Road between Lake Otis Parkway and Elmore Road; and that the Municipality of Anchorage enforces these speed limits.
