Assembly Report: (Next Meeting is May 10)
At the April $26^{\text {th }}$ meeting, the Assembly approved the $1^{\text {st }}$ Quarter Budget Revisions: Highlights follows:

- $\$ 1.07 \mathrm{M}$ for Vote by Mail Start-Costs which include equipment
- \$425,000 to assist with Homelessness issues
- \$250,000 Attorney Fees

Assembly approved amendments follows:

- $\$ 5 \mathrm{M}$ property tax rebate depending on availability of funds on or after September 1, 2016 and no later than December 31, 2016
- $\quad \$ 51 \mathrm{~K}$ for a Code Enforcement Officer to assist with the marijuana industry regulation.
- $\$ 83 \mathrm{~K}$ for an additional Fire Inspector
- $\$ 75 \mathrm{~K}$ to 4 A 's to provide housing support for 13 clients

The Assembly also set the 2016 Mill Levy as follows:

- ASD Mill Levy - 6.73
- General Government Mill Levy - 8.16
- Total Mill Levy - 14.89
- Taxes on a $\$ 350,000$ home before exemptions - $\$ 5,211.50$
- Taxes on a $\$ 350,000$ home after $\$ 20,000$ Residential Exemption - $\$ 4,913$
- Taxes on a $\$ 350,000$ home after $\$ 150,000$ Senior Citizen or Disabled Veteran Exemption and \$20,000 Residential Exemption - \$2,680
