The regular cleaning (picking up garbage, etc.) of David Green Park is being noticed and appreciated. Concern that the "fix" of the flooded sand pit, did not actually "fix" it was also expressed.

-The Municipality is 58.2% through the 2016 budget year with 56% of the budget expended.

-Departments are managing budgets well. Department have been requested to save 0.5% of the 2016 budget. -Due to the State's reduction in the Permanent Fund distribution, the MOA will lose \$1M+ in PFD garnishments.

-The Administration must submit the 2017 budget to the Assembly by October 1st.

-Public Hearings will be held on October 18th and October 25th after 6:00 p.m.
