

Tudor Area Community Council Meeting Minutes

Deanne Tuckerman, chair, called the meeting to order at 7:12 p.m. Last month's meeting minutes were approved.

Assembly Report: Assemblywoman Elvi Gray-Jackson said the Uber ordinance was approved. There will be a work session on precious metal sellers reporting requirements on April 7th. This was Elvi's last meeting as Assemblywoman. Her notes are included below. Mr. Traini had nothing to add.

Legislative Report: Representative Josephson's representative, Paul Kelly, said the legislature was at Day 80. The budget funding solution is not yet at hand. The House is attempting to reorganize the oil tax credit system. (Good luck!) Call Andy if you have concerns.

FCC Report: Jake Tuckerman gave a short run-down on the last Federation of Community Councils meeting.

Old Business: There was discussion of Scott Thomas's report on traffic accidents at Tudor Rd. and MacInnes St. that we received last month. Mr. Traini said that he will add the conduit supporting the Tudor Rd. traffic light to the Muni's bond package. We need to send a letter to the Scott Thomas, DOT traffic engineer asking for the conduit.

New Business: The Capital Improvement Plan discussion will held next meeting. There was some discussion on how mail-in votes are counted; this in relation to the Muni's plan to have all elections held by mail-in ballot. Mr. Traini said there is a new facility to work in and that all of the equipment to process the mail-in ballots is on hand.

- AO 2017-30, as amended which regulates Transportation Network Companies aka Uber was approved at the March 21st meeting. The vote was 6-4 with one member absent.

- AO 2017-31 to provide for record keeping and reporting requirements and other requirements for scrap and precious metal dealers was heard at the February 28th meeting. Assembly action was postponed until the April 11th meeting. A Work Session is scheduled on Friday, April 7th from 11:30 – 12:30. A substitute version will be available on line.
- AO 2017-36 to amend the Code to include unauthorized operation of unmanned aerial vehicles aka Drones was heard at the February 28th meeting. Assembly action was postponed until the April 11th meeting. There will be several proposed amendments to the ordinance.
- The 1st Quarter Budget Revision resolution and mill levy ordinances for both General Government and the School District will be introduced at the April 11th meeting. A Work Session is scheduled for Friday, April 7th from 12:30 – 1:00 p.m.
