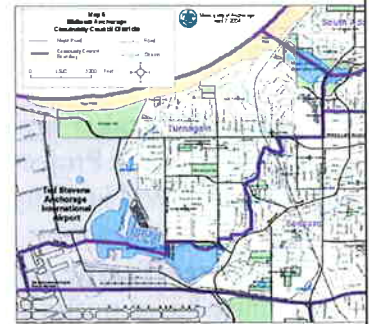

**Turnagain Community Council Meeting Summary, March 2, 2006**

**I. Legislative Report.** Senator French gave the Legislative report.

**II. Assembly Report.** Assemblymember Pamela Jennings gave an Assembly report.

**III. APD Liaison.** Sgt. Cindi Stanton discussed TCC area 2004 / 2005 crime statistics. Theft of vehicles with keys in the ignition and break-ins of vehicles at Connor's Bog Dog Park were among topics discussed.

**IV. Marston/Foraker and Pump Station 10 Development.** Bruce Robson gave an update on the Pump Station 10/Marston Project. A 65% design of the Pump Station 10 project will be presented at a May Public Meeting. AWWU is doing a more detailed review of construction routes and impacts to streets.

**V. TCC Area Traffic Calming Study.** DOWL Engineers gave a presentation on the development of a community-based traffic calming study. The goal is to identify collector roads and roads below collector status where there is speeding and cut-throughs. A TCC subcommittee that has formed to work with DOWL in developing the report. A draft report is scheduled for May.

**VI. Anchorage Tomorrow Presentation on Road and Parks Bonds.** Anchorage Tomorrow gave a presentation in favor of the municipal road and park bonds.

**VII. Didlika Park Improvement Project.** Cameron Sordahl gave a presentation on his Eagle Scout Project to construct a new wood fence to replace the damaged chain link fence, among other projects. He is working with TCC to apply for a Rasmussen Foundation Matching Grant. Donations can be sent to Cameron Sordahl, 2440 Captain Cook Drive, Anchorage, AK 99517. **VIII. Federation of Community Councils E-mail Policy.** TCC adopted a resolution to approve the current approach to have the President filter e-mails for the general membership and rely on the TCC Web site to post information provided to the President from FCC

**IX. Park Advisory Group.** Cathy Gleason, TCC's representative to the Municipality's Northwest District Park Advisory Group. They are working to identify park projects and then prioritize those projects as a community. The council agreed to Didlika Park as the Clean & Green project for Turnagain this summer.
