Legislative Report: Jacob Tatum was present for Berta Gardner's office and gave us a handout and update on their current priorities. Session starts soon, January 16, and the fiscal plan will be a paramount issue. They'll also be working on; an ADF&G issue about potentially removing goats & sheep from the "clean list" of domestic animals, the minimum age for getting married in Alaska (currently 14 with judge's approval, want it at possibly 18), and increasing the amount of time one can get birth control for (at a time) from 3 months to 12 months.

ASD Report: Cathleen Plunkett was present from the Anchorage School Board and gave us a handout and update. They need a fiscal plan to get their budget to the Assemble by March 1 (this is always a challenge due to logistics of when they get their budget from the state). The community really came together to help & support College Gate Elementary after the fire (a window was broken and a flare was thrown into a classroom causing much damage).
