May 5, 2005

Meeting called to order at 7:12pm by President Hoffman

Board members present: Bob Hoffman, Bob Laule, Bob Brock

Introduction of Guests followed by their presentations

Chugach Electric Transmission Route Section update presented by Dell Lau rue of Travis/Peterson Environmental Consulting.

After going through the review and selection process, the route chosen will follow the Alaska railroad line to O'Malley road. It will then follow O'Malley to the existing transmission line on Abbot Road. After permitting and right of way issues are completed, construction is expected to start in 2007

Klatt Bog Restoration updated presented by Linda Cyra-Korsgaard of CH2M Hill

Due to the Army Corp of Engineers being sued, the permit to develop the Turnagain bog by the Ted Stevens International Airport was revoked with no future plans to re-issue the permit in the near future. With no permit in hand, the airport will no longer follow through with the restoration process of the Klatt bog. All lands acquired have been conveyed to the Municipality of Anchorage and may only be used as parkland with limited access via trails allowed. No future development will be allowed. Information and outline to complete the work is available.

An announcement by neighbor Pillow that the Blood Bank of Alaska will be having a blood drive at the new Firehouse (station 15) on May 29th. Flyers with details were offered.

Capital Project Ranking

Using the projects list provide to the council for road and related projects, the group worked together to produce a ranking order of those projects in order of importance. Several suggestion for additions were discussed and added to the list. After the order was selected, a motion by Bob Hoffman was read aloud to accept the order. The motioned was seconded by Bob Brock and was approved by unanimous vote.

Assemblyperson Janice Shamburg gave a short presentation of Municipal business including the proposed changes in the upcoming Pesticide use vote. Details of the change were presented with a short discussion. The current assembly positions on AMATS are now filled by Chris Birch and Debbie Ossiander.
