Todd Butler, chair, called meeting to order at 7:10pm in the Fire Station break room, the February minutes were approved.

### **Legislative Report:**

#### **Assembly Report:** Dick Traini

- Mail out ballot – goes out by 13 March. Fill out and return via mail, drop of boxes or at accessible voting locations.
- Fuel tax took effect today – will be used to offset property taxes.
- On Tuesday the assembly passed ordinance to provide police coverage of the Seward Highway to Girdwood.
- On March 20<sup>th</sup> public hearing on school budget for ASD.

**ASD Report:** Cathleen Plunkett was present from the Anchorage School Board and gave us a handout and update. Bond issue request before voters will add total of \$50.6 million. ASD will retire \$56.5 million of bonds this year. Next year the State of Alaska will not reimburse for bonds so ASD will not retire as much next year. Other items happening in the school district:

- Item 11 – increase home exemption from \$20,000 to \$50,000
- KCC to be rebranded to King Tech High.
