- Eau Claire median: Diane is waiting for a new state Transportation Commissioner to be appointed to follow up. Campbell Park CC will join us in opposing this median.
- Seward Highway Study: Several preliminary alternatives have been proposed. They include widening between Dimond and 36th Avenue, taking of the median south of Dimond, a partial corridor widening, a no-build alternative, and a full corridor (which involves a raised or lowered highway, the taking of one house in our area, and no access to Seward Hwy via 36th Avenue except by frontage road).

- East Anchorage Transportation Study: preliminary alternatives have a great deal of bearing on our council area. Diane urged people to become involved at this relatively early stage in the process or else decisions regarding Tudor and Lake Otis, 36th Avenue, Bragaw, etc. will march along.

New Business:

- Council survey results: Over 50 surveys were returned. Results are attached.
- South Coastal Trail Extension: Andrée McLeod moved and Gil Cragen seconded that the Tudor Area Community Council take no position on this issue. The motion carried 4 to 2.
