4. swings, soccer posts, better drainage for David Green Park
5. make 14 acres south of St. Gotthard and north of Tudor Road into park
6. lights in David Green Park
7. speed bumps on MacInnes.
8. renovation or relocation of Fire Station # 4 (proposed on city's list)

Motion carried. Barbara Brown is going to contact the Fire Dept again re: speed bumps.

Parks survey: the municipality is surveying all councils in conjunction with the effort to rewrite the master plan for city parks. The council's requests for parks were:

1. pedestrian overpass at David Green Park over 36th Avenue
2. swings, soccer posts, better drainage at David Green Park
3. lights at David Green Park
4. purchase 14 acres south of St Gotthard for parkland

Assembly Report: Assemblyman Van Etten provided copies of the proposed Accessory Dwelling Unit ordinance. After much discussion, Jeffrey Sauve moved, "Tudor Area Community Council opposes the proposed Accessory Dwelling Units ordinance because it is in direct conflict with our community council goals."
