

Meeting Summary, April 1, 2006

- I. Legislative Report.** Senator French gave the Legislative report.
- II. Assembly Report.** Assemblymembers Pamela Jennings and Dan Sullivan gave the Assembly report.
- III. Announcements.** TCC is forming a standing Parks Committee. Anyone interested should contact Cathy Gleason. Report on TCC Board members' unsuccessful meeting with the Airport on Echo Parking Expansion alternatives.
- IV. Didlika Park Grant Proposal Application.** Deborah O'Leary discussed the "Friends of Didlika Park" Grant Application for a Parks Foundation Grant.
- V. National Veterans Wheelchair Games.** Kate Hollford gave a presentation on this national event to be held in multiple venues around Anchorage on July 3-8. The VA is looking for local volunteers.
- VI. Westchester Lagoon/Chester Creek Fish Passage Project.** David Wigglesworth, Community Creeks Development Manager for the Municipality gave a presentation on the Muni's plans to improve salmon passage into Chester Creek by installing a new large culvert for fish passage and restoring a tidal stream entrance into Westchester Lagoon. A working group will be created to provide community input.
- VII. Huntington Park Fence.** The proposed fence project to abate noise was discussed. It was decided that the affected neighbors should decide whether they want a wooden fence installed and get back to the council.
- VIII. Title 21 Land Use Maps.** Cathy Gleason gave an overview of TCC comments on the proposed land use map for our area.
- IX. Extension of Lyn Ary Park.** Dave Nyman gave a presentation on community interest to extend Lyn Ary Park.
- X. Traffic Calming and Northern Lights Construction.** Matt Korshin of DOWL Engineers gave an update on the traffic calming study in Turnagain and noted that construction on Northern Lights will begin again soon and to expect heavy delays on Northern Lights as the bulk of the work will be done there.
- XI. APD Liaison.** Sgt. Cindi Stanton discussed crime issues in our area. .
