6:35 - Anchorage Solar – Ben

ROI: 8-10% on 30 yr. life span of the panels (Panels stronger than the roof)

Installs in 1 day for most homes– 6 to 8 weeks includes permitting

No batteries, prices have dropped a lot in the last few years

7-15k for most homes - 30% tax credit back from purchase

10 customers means another drop in price; one community got 33 houses this summer

Mostly US components – Chinese cells/inverters – 30 year life expectancy

No School Board Rep

Assembly – Forrest and Pete

ML&P sale – no big surprises, still 1 billion

APD trying to hire three dispatchers and other non-sworn officers

Homeless Cleanup – 215 tons removed/cleaned/thrown out

300 fewer homeless than a year ago – 18% reduction

Pleasant Valley Project – no money in 2019, 3 million in 2020

Upgrade to police headquarters on Elmore, moving downtown

-retrofit the existing/old headquarters (elmore) for evidence storage facility

Budget Deficit - 6 million dollars of budget cuts this year

-In the future ML&P will assist the budget deficit

-We are taxing to the cap

7:18 State Rep Lance Pruitt

Oil is higher than expected, less of a budget deficit than we thought

Estimated 2.4 billion deficit was only 1.7 billion actual (this is offset by the CBR)

PFD Stats:

CBR is at 2.5 Billion

Earnings Reserve 19 Billion

Corpus is 49 billion

State Sen. Not present

Trail along Campbell Airstrip Road – Designed in 2019, built in 2020
