Resolution Supporting issuance of a Conditional Use Permit for an existing Alaska Communications 180' self-support tower and communications facilities located at 12715 Golden Eagle Drive in Eagle River.

WHEREAS, Ms. Alissa Haynes of Alaska Communications requested the opportunity to make, and has made a formal presentation to the community and the ERVCC membership at the February 13, 2019 meeting; and,

WHEREAS, the tower currently enables, for the Eagle River area, wireless communications services of cellular, internet, radio and television broadcast as well as microwave backhaul links from the Matsu Valley to Eagle River and Anchorage; and,

WHEREAS, the tower height and location of this facility is imperative to continue effective functioning of the Alaska Communications Systems and the existing network and broadcasts stations and services; and,

WHEREAS, no changes are planned to the current use of the facilities at this site; and,

WHEREAS, current use is compatible with the permit standards through a Conditional Use Permit; and

WHEREAS, the current use is not inconsistent with the intent of Title 21 zoning and land use regulations;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Eagle River Valley Community Council hereby declares its support for the continued use of Alaska Communications tower and facilities located at 12715 Golden Eagle Drive in Eagle River; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the ERVCC membership recommends that the Municipality of Anchorage approve a Conditional Use Permit for this site.
