DRAFT Turnagain Community Council Minutes—June 2006 Meeting

Mark Wiggin, President, called the meeting to order and made opening remarks.

- I. Assembly Report. Assemblypersons Dan Sullivan and Pamela Jennings gave an assembly report.
- **II.** <u>Legislative Report</u>. Senator Hollis French gave the Legislative report concerning the Petroleum Production Tax Proposal and the Capital Budget.
- **III.** Right Turn Lane on Minn/Northern Lights. DOT gave a presentation on the right turn lane project for southbound northern lights blvd at Minnesota. The TCC expressed concerns about pedestrian safety design and landscaping.
- **IV.** <u>35th and McCrae Road Improvement Project</u>. The TCC took up reconsideration of its prior resolution requesting delay of the project. A new resolution was adopted (39 to 0) urging the project's rejection.
- V. <u>Anchorage Citizens Coalition</u>. Cheryl Richardson gave a presentation concerning land use issues that are of concern to property owners and citizens.
- VI. <u>Traffic Calming</u>. Matt Korshin of DOWL Engineers gave an update on the Traffic Calming Study in Turnagain.
- VIII. <u>Capital Improvement Program (CIP) List, Turnagain Area</u>. The TCC approved proposed project ranking recommendations.
