DRAFT Turnagain Community Council Minutes Meeting Summary September 7, 2006

I. <u>Assembly Report</u>. Assembly persons Dan Sullivan and Pamela Jennings gave the Assembly report.
II. Legislative Report. Allison Biastock, aide to Sen. Hollis French, provided a Legislative report.

III. <u>Pump Station 10/Marston-Foraker Development</u>. Bruce Robson provided an update on behalf of AWWU. He distributed copies of AWWU's proposal on construction access routes and a preferred alternative route down McKenzie Blvd. (route 4). He invited TCC members to form a work group to meet with AWWU to develop mitigation measures for truck and construction traffic. Mark Wiggin agreed to form such a group. A 95% design public hearing will be held in Nov. 2006.

IV. <u>35th and McCrae</u>. Mark Wiggin briefed the TCC on the successful meeting with Mayor Begich and the Municipality and the Neighbors Coalition on a redesign of the 35th & McCrae Road Project.

V. <u>North Lights Project</u>. Matt Korshin gave an update on the status of the North Lights project south of Wisconsin/Turnagain Parkway.

VI. <u>Airport Issues</u>. Airport staff, including the new Airports Communications Manager, Linda Bustamante, gave an update on the General Aviation Master Plan and other issues at the Airport.

VII. <u>Chugach Electric</u>. Chugach Electric gave a presentation on the new postmark bog electric substation and the wind turbine project on Fire Island.
