Meeting Minutes Summary October 1,2009

I. *West Anchorage District Plan.* The Council adopted a resolution urging the Administration and Assembly to restore full funding to the West Anchorage District Plan. Persons interested in the District Plan should contact Breck Tostevin or Cathy Gleason. See TCC website for the resolution.

II. *Marston-Foraker Pump Station 10.* Jeff Coleman from AWWU provided the last time update on this project. To be completed are the punch list, survey and landscape details. Project will be completed by the end of the month - on schedule. Mr. Coleman said that the replacement of the gate at the Lyn Ary Park Parking lot entrance is in the plan. Mr. Coleman also said that bollards will be placed at all trail heads. Arborist has inspected the plantings and there are no more plans to add more trees because trees were put in with room to grow. Members thanked Jeff and Pruhs for their consideration of the neighborhood during the project.

III. *Lyn Ary Master Plan.* An update of Master Plan efforts in June-October were provided. Current plans are for a master plan presentation in November and a Council vote in December.

IV. *De-Icing Fluid Pollution Control at Ted Stevens Anchorage Intl. Airport.* John Parrott, Airport Manager, and Scott Lyle, Environmental Manager from TSAIA provided the presentation. EPA proposed new effluent guidelines for deicing in August – comments due by Oct 28. Options include technologies to reduce, treat, or recycle de-icing fluids. The proposed Rules would prohibit the use of urea on runways but urea is not being used now due to cost. The airport uses between 250,000- 500,000 gallons of de-icing fluid a year. Most runoff goes into Cook Inlet, some into Lake Hood. Lake Hood/Spenard Lake now meets the dissolved oxygen standards 90% of time and the airport is asking DEC to delist it as an impaired waterbody. Infrared deicing could be one of the technologies used to reduce use of de-icing fluids since it cuts glycol use by 90%.
