The Rabbit Creek Community Council was excited to hear Grace Johnston's presentation about her Anchorage Park Foundation Challenge Grant proposal, *Moen Park Challenge Grant*, at our recent meeting, March 14<sup>th</sup>. Improving our neighborhood Moen Park with the addition of adult exercise equipment, a Best Beginnings lending library, and signage to discourage illegal activity are all excellent ideas we would like to see implemented. As you know, southeast Anchorage is lacking in parks, and these additions will enhance the opportunities for parents to get in some exercise while their children are playing in the Moen Park playground, add variety and options for other adults to exercise, promote reading, and improve the safety of our neighborhood park.
