

Resolution 2018-02
Requesting that the Fairview Community Council be included in high-level discussions about the future of the ML&P campus

Whereas the Municipality of Anchorage has proposed the sale of Municipal Light and Power (MLP) to Chugach Electric, and

Whereas MLP holds significant real estate assets within the Fairview Community Council boundaries, and

Whereas Chugach Electric has indicated that they intend to vacate many of the properties occupied by MLP if the sale is approved and finalized, and

Whereas the real estate assets of MLP represent a significant land holding that may come under the control of the Municipality of Anchorage, and

Whereas the Municipality of Anchorage is considering using the vacated properties for an expanded campus for services for the homeless population of Anchorage, and

Whereas it is the position of the Fairview Community Council that the concentration of social services has led to an increasingly dangerous environment in North Fairview, and

Whereas the Municipality has responded to the problems in North Fairview by increasing police, security, and outreach presence, and

Whereas any new plans may increase the volume of homeless individuals served,

Therefore be it resolved that the Fairview Community Council respectfully request that no plans be considered by the Administration without a representative of the Fairview Community Council involved in the discussions, and

Be it further resolved, that the Fairview Community Council will review any plans in light of improving public safety, impacts on neighbors, and success of any project in moving more individuals out of homelessness, and

Be it further resolved that this position be communicated to the Mayor's office.
