APPROVAL OF MINUTES FROM PRIOR MEETING: Of March 7, 2019

ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY REPORT: This election was the highest turnout for an assembly election. Felix Rivera is the new chair of the Assembly. Meg Zalatel is newly elected.

GUEST SPEAKERS:

Lou Weaver and Chris Owens, from AK Slow Burn Cannabis, presented their business model for a new retail store located at 1551 E. Tudor Rd. They already have a store in Mountain View. A lively discussion was had as the company owner described how the business would integrate into the local community while under pressure from residents to explain how a smooth traffic flow would be maintained on Tudor Road and how people would be dissuaded from parking on the local side streets to smoke pot. The business owner will also have to appear before the Campbell Creek Council before he can apply to the municipality for a license.

Arthur Keyes, from Glacier Valley Farm, is establishing a farmer's market at the BP Center's parking lot this summer. Arthur already operates the Southside farmers market and is very enthusiastic about bringing a market to Midtown. The market will be there every Saturday beginning on June 22nd.
