Minutes for May 26, 2005

Meeting called to order at 7:13 by Chair Al Tamagni Sr
Minutes were approved.
Treasures Report: No report.

Committee Reports:

Assembly Report: Chris Birch reported that he was looking at Fire issues on Hillside. Quick response vehicles are set up. A helicopter is also on retainer with a bucket for Hillside fires. He requested folks call if they had any questions.

Roads & Projects: Handout was provided. Bill Johnson of CRW provided updates regarding Spruce Street and 84th. Design is 95% completed and construction slated for 2006. Dell LaRue of Chugach Electric provided an update on the transmission line upgrade 138V. He reported on the four possible routes 1. Lore 2. O'Malley 3. Abbott 4. Huffman. Design will be completed in 2006 and project will be completed by 2007. At the moment O'Malley via ARRC will have the lowest # of impacted parcels, the lowest # of easement, and the lowest cost. AWWU indicated the water main issue will be in front of the Assemble on June 27th.

Parks & Rec: Shawne Popovici from Municipality of Anchorage reported on changes within Parks and Recreation. A Central and Southeast Park District has been created and she will be the assigned staff member. The Municipality has also created a Park Foundation to accept financial donations that can help individual parks in the community. The Municipality is looking into repairs for Meadow Park. Additionally, special user groups will be looking at fees. Shawne in response to a request will provide definition of Parks to include Neighborhood Parks, Open Space Parks, Multi Use Parks, etc.

Legislative Report: No report.

Old Business: Discussion of the need for a by-laws committee to review the council by-laws to bring them into compliance with the new Municipality ordinance regarding minimum standards for council by-laws. Committee members are Al Tamagni, Charisse Millett and Lynda Zaugg. Meeting scheduled for 8 p.m. Wed. June 1st at Abbott Loop Christian Church. Lynda Zaugg will replace Joan as the new Secretary for the Council.

New Business: Crawford Parks indicated concern regarding the school zones for Spring Hill and Hanshew. He pointed out that two zones have a small space for normal speed between the zones which he believes is confusing. He suggested a larger sign, a mid point sign or a notice that this was a long school zone.
