Assembly Report: Elvi Gray-Jackson reported on action of MOA Assembly. 1. ID check ordinance put on hold to allow liq. Stores opportunity to try for 100% compliance. This was at the request of liq. Stores. 2. The bus auto change for traffic lights has been approved for a one year trial. 3. The bike plan was approved with a couple of ER amendments. It will be reconsidered at the next assembly meeting. 4. The Red Roof Inn ordinance will be reconsidered as the new amendment changed the # of feet such a facility must be from a park. Amendment moved from 250 ft to 500 ft. This means Red Roof Inn plan cannot go forward. 5. Assembly voted to support Sen. Bill 109 to drop H.S. test requirements.

Assembly Candidate Dick Tranini gave a brief presentation.

Jacques Boutet from Boutet Company talked about Independence Drive work. It is moving forward. This season will see it connected to O'Mally. The cross walks at some of the intersection do not meet code and will have to be repaired at contractor's expense. Next year they will be able to open the road as completely done with lights, drainage, etc.

Jacques Boutet also speaking on behalf of Anch Tomorrow Community Action Group in favor of Prop 1 Road bond, Prop 4 public transportation and Prop 5 the no cost land swap.

Wendy Wilber from CRW updated the Co. re projects in the area: 72nd, Spruce, & Lori to be finished with landscaping, sidewalks, and clean up. 73 & 74th are in design with const. set to begin in 2012. 88th work will continue in June.

Old Business: None

New Business: Problem on Nadine St – large number of parked cars causing problems. Al t will work with enforcement to address the problem. Crossing problem at Covington and Elmore to new park is dangerous!

School Board: Pat Higgins reported on the school board. Discussed the cost per student here vs Seattle or San Fran. Per Pat not comparing the same things – not comparing apples to apples.
