**FCC Bob Laule**

- Youth delegates must be 16 years old or older
- Streaming for Council meetings
- Construction funding from Federal Earthquake expenses may go toward the backlog of State work.
- Property review for APD and AFD

**Legislator Reports**

*House – Chuck Kopp*

- House passed supplemental budget for 2020 ending June 2020
- Need to repay for 2019 fire, Medicaid, Pioneer homes. Marine Ferry System through June 30)
- Committee formed to review Alaska Marine Highway System
- 2021 budget is done. Going to floor for vote
- PFD Bill introduced
- PFS payout at \$3000 equals deficit. \$1000 pay out equals no deficit
- EPA Clean Water tier II act introduced for salmon protection instead tier III
- Tribal recognition effort being put forth by the State
- Public safety retirement bill proposed to lower State cost by putting more onto employee. Several other changes outlined.
- PFD withdrawal is \$3.2 billion, \$1.5 billion oil tax and \$500 million mining revenues to fund budget
- SB26 takes 5.25% value of fund then drops to 5% going forward
