- Disaster Assistance: Severe Winter Storms: If your home, personal property or private business was damaged by the **March 6-14** windstorm, you may be eligible for federal disaster assistance. To find out if you are eligible call 1-800-621-3362. The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) will open a disaster recovery center on Wednesday, May 7, 3630 E. Tudor Road. The center will be open Tue - Fri, 8A - 6P and Sat 9A - 1P. Disaster recovery is joint effort between FEMA and the State of Alaska Division of Emergency Services.
