Overview

In 2006, the Anchorage Assembly established the Historic Preservation Program and the Historic Preservation Commission (HPC). The HPC has drafted a Local Landmark Register Ordinance for public review. When adopted, the ordinance will assist in the recognition of the unique cultural and historic resources found throughout the Municipality.

The recognition of cultural and historic resources gives the public valuable information about the people who came before, their struggles, successes, and way of life. Local landmark registers are a foundational element of historic preservation programs throughout the world enabling communities to survey, recognize, and preserve their unique history and culture by inventorying and listing these resources with an adopted local landmark register.
