**Assembly – John Weddleton/Suzanne LaFrance**

- Operating Budget \$548 million (1% Increase, less than inflation)
  - o +100\$ for houses \$350,000
  - o Alcohol Tax
    - \$11-15 mil, only allocating \$9mil
  - o October 27, November 4 – Public Hearings
- Cares Act Funds
  - o \$10mil of contingency moved to Small Business Funds
    - \$71mil has been given to businesses
- Emergency Proclamation
  - o Sullivan would have to close as a shelter
    - Facility tours are available
  - o End of November
  - o Attempting to make items into Code

- Mayor Resigned
  - o Austin Quinn Davidson is to become acting Mayor
    - Choice – Special Election or Regular Election
      - Must wait 90 days at minimum
    - New mayor for 3.5 months and then normal election would occur
    - Cost \$670,000 to run the election
    - Show of hands for regular election, with an accelerated handover
    - Assembly is ready to override mayoral orders that are deemed out of line
- Building Code
  - o Sprinkler Issue – Nearby water sources for Fire Fighters
  - o City viewed this as increasing options as you could install sprinklers if you were not near a supply
  - o More remote councils seem to be against this
  - o John is pushing against single family home, townhouses as a requirement
    - And that home remodels less than 50% of the home value not trigger the requirement
- APD – 1.8mil Bond – ½ for body cameras
  - o December 8th public hearing

- Bayshore Drive – Uninterrupted roadway Posted 30mph
  - o Significant increase west of Bayshore Pond
  - o 40-50mph typical, outliers can be much faster
  - o Noise and Traffic volume are becoming a problem
  - o Discovery Heights Phase 4 HOA supported unanimously
