1. Call to Order – The Campbell Park Community Council (CPCC) gathered on Zoom at 7:04 PM.
2. The agenda was approved.
3. The minutes of the November 19th meeting were approved.

4. Reports

A. Assembly

1. Felix Rivera –Assembly has appropriated \$15M CARES Act funds for small business relief, targeting hospitality and entertainment, and renter’s relief. These funds are exhausted. A request for additional federal funds is in progress. The proposal for a bonded tax increase to pay for body camera and IT upgrade proposal for the police is being postponed pending effort to identify funding in the operating budget.

2. Meg Zaletel –The Assembly has published two Assembly 101 video and a new Assembly main page. The Assembly meetings are now on the radio on KRUA, 88.1 FM, in addition to being on GCI channel 9 and the muni website. At AMATS meeting today, Department of Transportation outlined ten options for dealing with the problem sections of Tudor road. If desired, Meg will attempt to get a speaker from DOT for the January meeting.

B. Legislature

1. Senator Elvi Gray-Jackson – The Legislature will convene on January 19th. The governor’s budget of \$294.6M is based on budget cuts in numerous agencies and functions. Elvi will introduce legislation to make Juneteenth a paid state holiday in Alaska. Juneteenth is recognized by 47 states. She and Senator Begich are working on legislation for reform of police practices to reduce police violence.

2. Representative Andy Josephson – Preparing bills to increase penalties for oil spills, currently as set in 1976 levels; to increase worker’s compensation damages for survivable injuries; to provide Tier 5 pension plan for first responders, in order to prevent loss of first responders to other states; to outlaw housing discrimination based on sexual identity; to establish hate crimes as an escalator in state criminal code; and to provide worker’s compensation in COVID related cases.

C. Mayor’s Office – No report.

D. School Board – Margo Bellamy. Board approved Superintendent’s option to opening school even in event of continued emergency order. ASD Back In School document is available at <https://www.asdk12.org/cms/lib/AK02207157/Centricity/Domain/5417/Back%20in%20School%20Plan>

C. Draft Assembly Ordinance Amending Title 21 – Land Use Planning for Homeless and Transient Shelters – Francis McLaughlin, Senior Planner for Municipal Planning Department, described project to revise Title 21 to permit homeless shelters in B3 Zoning districts, in addition to PL1 land, which is mostly parkland and institutional land. The proposed Title change includes the nine criteria which must be met before the Planning Commission could approve a conditional use permit for a homeless shelter in a B-3 district. A public hearing on the proposed change will be held in March 2021. The Planning and Zoning Commission will then make a recommendation to the Assembly. The Assembly will hold a public hearing in May or June 2021. The proposal includes no specific locations for future homeless shelters.
