- The house appears to be wrapping up the operating budget. I don't know of the exact timing, but I hope they are able to pass it over to the senate in the next week or so. The senate has done all of the budget prep, so I think it will move quickly from there.
- The capital budget is being worked on now. That will pass from the senate to the house in the last two weeks of session, so early to mid-May.
- We're still hoping to be done in Juneau on day 121, which is May 20th.
