1. We are for honesty and transparency.
2. We are against lying.
3. We are against cheating.

5. We believe in fact-checking.
6. We believe in science and objective reality.
7. We are for learning about facts, evidence, and what others have to say about something—even if some people may be against learning about these matters because they may allow them to change their minds or actions about something.

8. We understand that a group of people which is not interested in fact-checking or the truth, can help other people make some very bad decisions, and to behave in ways in which they would not otherwise behave.
9. We understand that the right thing to do, and what a majority of people want to do, can be very different things, especially without fact-checking.
10. We are against trying to invoke or insert the Holocaust into matters of public health, such as mask use or vaccinations.
