NOTICE OF EXTENSION OF LAND USE PERMIT: The State of Alaska, Department of Transportation and Public Facilities (DOT&PF), Ted Stevens Anchorage International Airport (Airport) proposes to execute a supplement to extend the Land Use Permit under ADA-32342, as follows: **LESSEE:** Municipality of Anchorage/Port of Alaska. **PREMISES:** 600 square feet area at Point Woronzof Viewpoint Parking Lot. **LEASE TERM:** January 1, 2020 through December 31, 2022. **LEASE RENTAL RATE:** \$250 one-time fee. **PROPOSED AUTHORIZED USES:** Placement of a connex that will be manned and used for monitoring marine mammal (beluga whales).

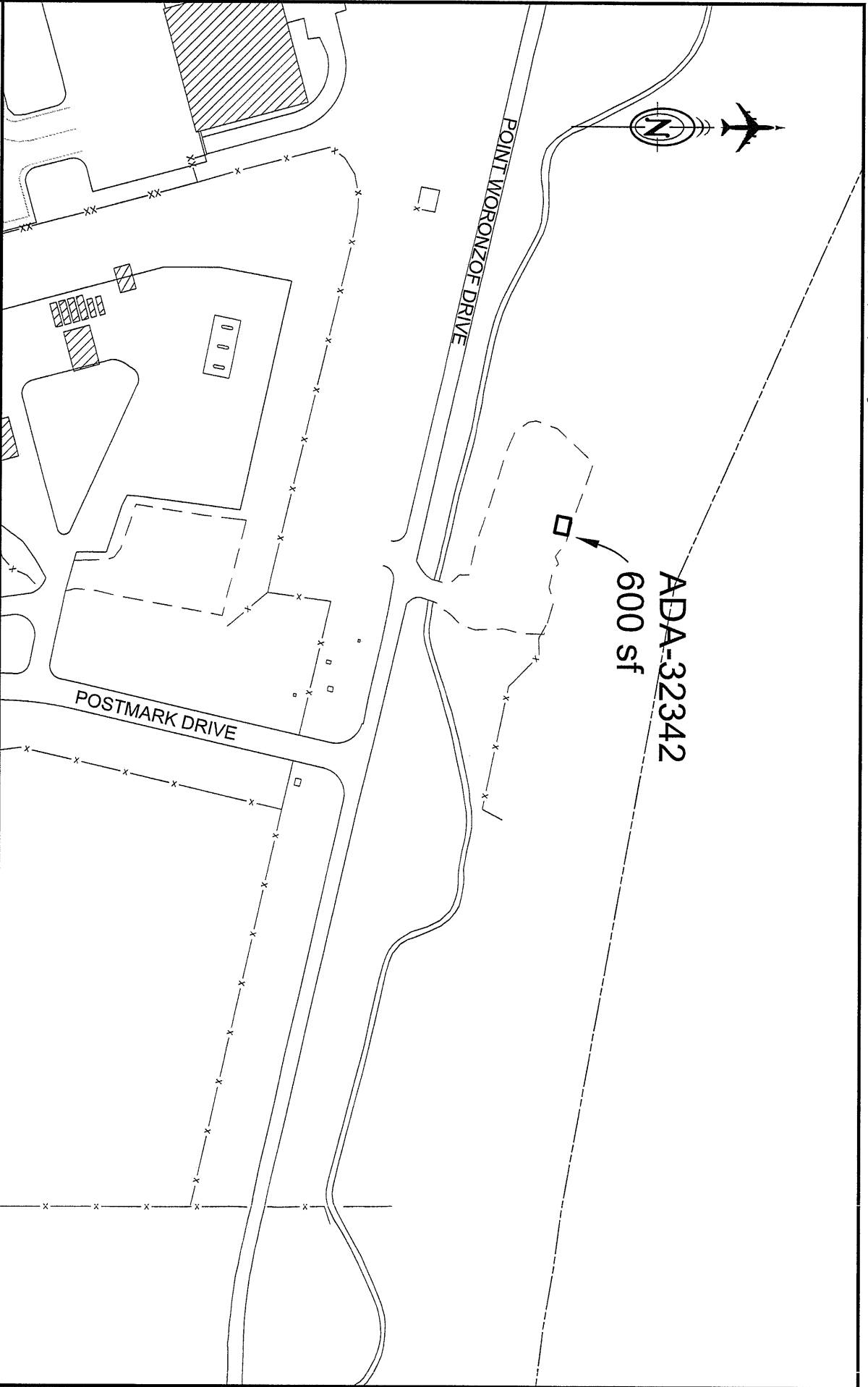
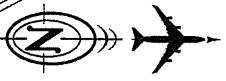

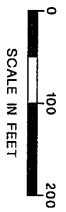
