Effective March 1, Joint Base Elmendorf-Richardson (JBER) policy removes the mask wear requirement for fully immunized personnel in an indoor setting when the community level in the Anchorage Municipality is low or medium (as determined by applicable CDC guidance and definitions). Personnel who are not fully immunized must continue to wear a mask in an indoor setting on the installation.
